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Word	Meaning
Wind	Moving air that blows in winter and makes trees sway.
Winter	The cold season when it can snow and days are short.
Windy	When the air is blowing fast outside.
Wet	Covered with rain, melted snow, or slush.
White	The color of snow, frost, and a snowy landscape.
Warm	Nice and cozy; the opposite of cold.
Wool	Soft, fluffy material from sheep used for warm clothes.
Wraps	Scarves, shawls, or blankets you wrap around yourself.
Waterproof	Material that keeps water and snow out.
Walking	Going for a walk in the snow or on icy paths.
Wading	Stepping through deep snow like it is water.
Warming up	Getting cozy again after being outside in the cold.
Watching	Looking at snowflakes, icicles, or your frosty breath.
Wondering	Thinking and asking questions about winter.
Woodpeckers	Birds that tap on tree trunks even in winter.
Wolves	Wild dogs with thick fur that live in snowy forests.
Whales	Big sea animals; some swim in cold winter oceans.
Water	Turns into ice or snow when it is very cold.
Wood	Logs people burn in fireplaces to stay warm.
Warmth	The cozy feeling from heat, hugs, or blankets.
